Do you agree? Include your observations in addition to the examples provided by Zhang. Write a 5-7 sentences.

2) Heim and Anatrone (“Introduction”- *Queering Italian Media*) claim that the “idea of Italian national identity and nationhood has always been very dependent upon mediatic cultural representation?” (p. 1). Do you agree? Think about the relations between spectator and film. How might this tradition impact understandings and the inclusivity of queer identities/ the queer community in Italy? Are queer person/ the queer community in Italy represented accurately and authentically? Include your reflections on *Puoi baciare lo sposo* in addition to your anticipation about future media representations of queer identities/ the queer community in Italy. Write 7-10 sentences.
